NEW DRIVER CLASS C LICENSING

- Complete the Naval Safety Center approved EVOG Curriculum and Driving Course, and obtain approved EVOG Instructor sign off.
- Notify Training Chief of intent to register for Department of Defense CDC Driver/Operator-Pumper and arrange for proper apparatus training material.
- Upon successful completion of the Department of Defense CDC Driver/Operator- Pumper submit the following documents to the Training Chief:
 - Copy of CDC Driver/Operator Completion Certificate
 - Completed DMV DL 546, see EVOG Program Administration for a blank copy
 - Completed OF 346, see EVOG Program Administration for a blank copy
 - Copy of signed Naval Safety Center approved current EVOG Course certification of completion

Upon receipt of the above completed documents, the EVOG Program Administration will request the Fire Chief's signature on the Verification of Employment Letter for the DMV. All documents will be returned to the candidate to submit to the DMV. The candidate will still need to:

- Fill out a DMV DL 44 (available only from DMV)
- Submit DMV DL 546
- Submit DMV DL 88 (Endorsement Card) and Chief's Endorsement Letter
- Pay the appropriate application fee (\$28.00 addition to current, \$45.00 renewal)
- Successfully pass the written tests (Commercial Hand Book CH. 2)

The above actions should be completed at the Rancho San Diego DMV office for Commercial Licensing. Once the Firefighter has successfully achieved DMV certification, they can begin regular driver training with their crew.
